Take Aways from October Grand Rounds

COVID 19/Flu Concerns Dr. David Pratt

- Treating Moderate to Severe Covid
 - Oxygen monitoring important since may not have shortness of breathe
 - Remdesivir appears helpful in earlier stages of moderate disease
 - Dexamethasone best used in mid to later stage of severe disease
 - Monoclonal Antibodies no major conclusions yet

COVID 19/Flu Concerns

- The environment plays a role in transmission
 - With decreasing humidity and colder air, there is more chance of COVID virus being aerosolized.
 - Indoors has increased risk with virus being more available for transmission

COVID/Flu Concerns

- Co- infection with other Respiratory
 Viruses is possible.
- Other Resp. Viruses disrupt cilia of resp. track with dec. in mucus secretion and destruction of epithelium
- Making us more susceptible to more severe disease
- Possibility that one virus drives out another virus

- Almost no flu in Southern Hemisphere
- Not seeing usual surge of URIs in school children
- Seeing reduced COVID 19 mortality
- Likely due to use of masks and Social Distancing

Antibiotic Stewardship Tasha St. John, PharmD & Kate

- 30% of all antibx use is unnecessary
- 55% of all hospitalization get at least one dose of a broad spectrum antibx
- 4 Ds of Antibx Stewardship
 - Right Drug
 - Right Dose
 - Right Duration
 - De-escalation

Antibiotic Stewardship Grand Rounds

- 10% in US say they have a Pen Allergy, but only 1% are truly allergic
- Of this number 80% will become tolerant to penicillin
- Study shows that if identified as Pen Allergic, greater risk for poor outcomes
- 2020 TJC Outpatient project -
 - -De-label PCN Allergy

Neuro Complications with COVID 19 Dr. Brooks

- Neurologic Complications with COVID
 - Many Neuro practices closed with reduced patient volume
 - Reduced ED volume of Strokes
 - Cannot do a good Neuro Consultation via Telemedicine
 - No SARS 2 virus being found in CSF

Neurocomplications of COVID 19 Infections

The difficulty obtaining MRI with contagious state of COVID 19 has hampered the study of Neuro complications.

 Uncertain % of neuro complications are those associated with critical illness versus direct attack on nervous system
